VIOLENCE WOULD INCLUDE: -SETTING UP MORE MOBILE POLICE STATIONS IN TOWNSHIPS; -UTILIZING MORE VEHICLES AND ADDITIONAL AIR SUPPORT; -AND DISPATCHING MORE DETECTIVES AND SECURITY PERSONNEL TO SUPPLEMENT EXISTING NUMBERS, AS WELL AS THE USE OF ALL AVAILABLE LEGAL MEANS TO ROUND UP AND PROSECUTE RINGLEADERS AND ORGANIZERS OF VIOLENCE. VLOK SAID THE TROOP DEPLOYMENT WAS A RESPONSE TO REQUESTS FROM RESPONSIBLE LEADERS. SINCE THE BEGINING OF THE YEAR, 249 PEOPLE HAD DIED AND 250 WERE INJURED IN 916 UNREST INCIDENTS. BETWEEN THE BEGINNING OF THE MONTH AND TUESDAY (13 FEB) 101 MORE HAD DIED AND 135 MORE WERE INJURED IN 656 INCIDENTS. VLOK ADDED THAT 19 SECURITY FORCE MEMBERS WERE MURDERED AND 104 SERIOUSLY INJURED DURING THE TWO YEARS OF VIOLENCE.

2. (U) SOURCE B STATES THAT THE INABILITY OF THE SAP TO PROVIDE SECURITY AND BRING CRIMINALS TO JUSTICE HAD REDUCED CONFIDENCE I N THE POLICE. SOURCE ADDED THAT SINCE THE SITUATION WAS WORSENING AND THE POLICE WERE NOT COPING THE SADF HAD BEEN REQUESTED TO INTERVENE AS A DETERRENT, BUT THAT THIS ACTION SHOULD NOT BE PERCEIVED AS AN INTERVENTION TO "ENFORCE OPPRESSIVE LAWS" BUT RATHER AS A

MOVE TO ENSURE THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER AND SECURITY.
