CRCLI probably already have this material, however, just in case: in 2009, the Virginia Fusion Center put out a "Terrorism Threat Assessment". Despite being labeled LES, it was leaked to the press. Like the Right Wing Extremism product and the MIAC militia report, it got some press coverage and was attacked by the Virginia ACLU (which sent CRCL a letter requesting an investigation), though the criticisms were more muted than those levied against RWE or MIAC.
